The Thomaston and Cushing Boards of Selectmen will host a ribbon cutting ceremony on the new Wadsworth Street Bridge at 1 p.m., October 5<sup>th</sup> in conjunction with Maine Department of Transportation.

Maine Department of Transportation Commissioner David Bernhardt will emcee the event.

The ceremony will be conducted from the center of the new bridge. Slated to speak will be Margaret McCrea and Anne Guild from the Thomaston and Cushing Historical Societies with historical overviews of the bridge(s). State Representative Chuck Kruger and Senator David Miramant will speak. Selectboard Chairmen, Greg Hamlin of Thomaston and Alton Grover of Cushing, will be speaking. Reverend Peter Jenks; and Reverend Vanessa Winters will bless the bridge.

The cutting of the ribbon will be executed by our own Thomaston resident and historic boat builder, Raymond Wallace. Immediately following the ribbon cutting there will be a volley of shots discharged across the new bridge by David Martucci and William Wasson, in period dress of the Revolutionary and French & Indian wars.

Maine Department of Transportation Commissioner David Bernhardt, accompanied by Municipal Officials and citizens from Thomaston and Cushing will cross the bridge, from the Cushing side, in historic motor cars, circa 1928, provided by the Owls Head Transportation Museum and Wayne "Beaver" Stinson and Toby Stinson.
