This note is to inform you about our DNR talk coming up in early January so you can save the date and review your documents.....and maybe start a discussion with your loved ones about this important topic.

Members of the Cushing Rescue Squad have received a number of requests for information about orders for Do Not Resuscitate (or DNRs).

These are bit more complicated and require more than a few lines on a paper if you want to ensure that your wishes about your end of life will be carried out. In short, a 'Do-Not-Resuscitate Order' is a medical treatment order stating that cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) will not be attempted if your heart and/or your breathing stop.

Some other documents expressing your desires should also be in place, e.g., a living will (or advanced directive) and a durable power of attorney).

Rick Petrie, EMT-P, is the Executive Director of Atlantic Partners EMS whose mission is to enhance the delivery of emergency medical services for our region. He will discuss the utilization of DNR orders including the Maine EMS DNR program, Living wills, and "Do Not Treat Orders". He will discuss the options available to the public to make sure their wishes are known.
